Shooting is one of the fastest growing sports and PF/QF makes it easy to get youth and families involved in this popular pastime. Our programs...

Adopt-A-Team

Adopt a local youth shooting team or create one and help that team earn dollars that will support them forever. It's a great way to get involved in your community and help young people learn firearms safety and perfect their shooting skills.

Young Guns Program

This program helps you provide youth with a chance to participate in a variety of shooting sports in a safe and fun environment several times a year. We'll give you equipment and training and all you have to do is host the events.

Ammo Grants

Ammunition for youth shooting events is expensive so we will reimburse you for part of your costs. Send in your receipts and an event report form and we'll reimburse half of your costs up to \$1,000.

Forever Shooting Sports Endowment

Contribute to an endowment fund that has been established to support chapter shooting sports programs across the country and to provide a chance for high school students to attend the MidwayUSA Youth Wildlife Conservation Experience to learn about conservation and wildlife.
