Instructions for Adopt-A-Team <u>Deposits</u> For FOREVER Shooting Sports Program

This form is to be used when depositing Adopt-A-Team fundraising into a MidwayUSA Foundation, Inc. Team Endowment Account. Depending on the package your chapter bought, the deposit amounts should be \$1,000. Those funds will be matched 3:1 if sent in by November 30th 2014. If your deposit is after that date we are not sure what the match will be at that time. Currently, teams can apply for a grant once per calendar year, at which time they can pull up to 5% of their account balance.

All funds that are to be matched must be submitted to Pheasants Forever and made out to:

The following guidelines govern the award of all grants made under the auspices of the MidwayUSA Foundation, Inc. Team Endowment Account Program. In order for a shooting team to be eligible for a grant, the Foundation must have received donations naming the shooting team as the suggested beneficiary. Grants are not available to shooting programs that do not have a fund balance.

The maximum grant amount each year is equal to 5% of your individual team's account balance. This balance can be found on the MidwayUSA Foundation website (www.midwayusafoundation.org), under the "Find a Team" tab.

Please read this entire document prior to completing a grant application:

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS: An "Eligible group" is any organization, association or other entity, whether formally incorporated or not, that has, as a minimum, a unique federal employer identification number (EIN) issued by the Internal Revenue Service. Eligible groups may apply for a Team Endowment Account Program Fund grant for a qualifying project or activity. Grants are awarded to qualifying projects or activities that promote amateur shooting sports. Team Endowment Account Program Fund grants may benefit a variety of constituencies including youth, women, individuals with physical disabilities, and competitive teams. Applicants seeking to qualify for support shall not discriminate against any member or person on the basis of age, race, color, sex or national origin.

Projects/Activities Eligible for Funding: Proposed projects/activities must conform to and foster the purposes set forth in the MidwayUSA Foundation's Articles of Incorporation and mission statement. Allowable 501(c)(3) purposes that align with the MidwayUSA Foundation mission are limited to projects which are or include: charitable, educational, or fostering national or international amateur sports competition. Grant proceeds shall not be used to acquire firearms. Grant proceeds must be directly linked to the shooting team and shall not be used for club, high school, college, or university indirect costs. Grant proceeds shall not be used to lobby or otherwise attempt to influence legislation, to influence the outcome of any public election, to carry on any voter registration drive, or used to contribute to any political campaign of any candidate for public office. An application that fails to demonstrate that grant funds will be used for eligible project/activities will not be considered for funding.

General Provisions: The MidwayUSA Foundation, Inc. (Foundation) operates Team Endowment Accounts. The Foundation was incorporated in 2007 in the State of Missouri and is a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt public charity. Funding provided to Participating Organizations through the Team Endowment Program supports a variety of youth focused and firearms-related public interest projects and activities without regard to the age, race, color, religion, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, national origin, or disability of its benefactors in accordance with applicable federal, state and local laws. Foundation grants are not guaranteed and must be approved by the Foundation's Board of Directors. The Foundation reserves the right to audit the use of grant funding at any time and for any reason.
