The time is now!
At the heart of the Habitat Organization is our commitment to upland habitat conservation and the next generation of conservationists. It is clear that it will take all of our constituents working together to save the uplands. The uplands need us now more than ever, which is why Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever is actively delivering the Call of the Uplands campaign. This \$500 million strategic and science-based campaign is our best chance to come together around a common cause — a promise to conserve the uplands before it’s too late.

Diverse Membership
Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever members are a diverse group of hunters, farmers, ranchers, landowners, conservation enthusiasts, wildlife lovers and wildlife officials. The common thread: All want to make a difference for wildlife by conserving, enhancing and creating upland habitat. Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever’s upland conservation community represents over 400,000 members, supporters and partners, all dedicated to the protection of our uplands and the conservation of pheasants, quail and other wildlife.

Answering the Call of the Uplands®
North America’s prairies and grasslands are our planet’s most endangered ecosystem. These habitats are home to the thrilling ring-necked pheasant, all six species of our continent’s magnificent quail, and countless wildlife from butterflies and bees to songbirds, big game, and other gamebirds such as sage grouse, prairie chickens and sharp-tailed grouse. Our organization’s monumental, multi-year Call of the Uplands

campaign is putting millions of acres of wildlife habitat in the ground, creating public places for hunting and outdoor recreation, and making new hunters to carry on the conservation tradition.

Wildlife Habitat
Since Pheasants Forever’s inception in 1982 and Quail Forever’s launch in 2005, the organization’s 567,500+ on-the-ground projects (anchored by the work of our tireless chapters and supported by the work of our essential partners) have created and improved more than 22 million acres of upland wildlife habitat across the continent.

Public Lands
To date, Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever has participated in 1,725 land acquisitions totaling 218,591 acres of permanently protected habitat. These land acquisition projects have been completed in conjunction with local, state and federal natural resource agencies. And every acre is open to public hunting.

Conservation Advocacy
Our mission is directly tied to a strong framework of federal conservation programs, such as the Conservation Reserve Program (CRP), which is granted by the U.S. Congress in the Federal Farm Bill’s Conservation Title. We act as a voice for upland habitat and wildlife in Washington D.C. as well as statehouses across the pheasant and quail range. We are also working with a broad coalition of partners and members of Congress to introduce new legislation called the North American Grasslands Conservation Act that would enhance and conserve America’s grasslands, savannas, sagebrush steppe, prairie, and glade ecosystems.

Conservation Education
In an effort led by our hard-working chapters, Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever has developed programs and materials that promote conservation education and public awareness. In 2021 alone, the organization’s chapters hosted 1,297 events that impacted 40,898 youth and adult participants.

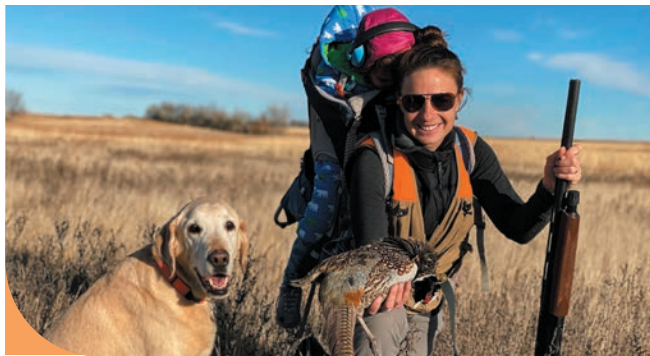

The inventor of the DeadFowl Trainer, Tom has more than 40 years of training experience. He

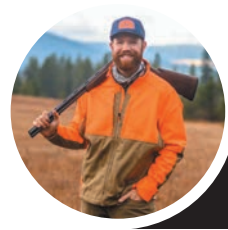

Hogan is an avid adventurer, outdoorswoman and certified natural foods chef. Turning

the high-quality protein that game meats provide into modern and healthful dishes is her signature. Hogan has been executive chef and upland hunting guide in South Dakota for the last eight seasons at Pine Shadows Daybreak Lodge, and hunts with her field bred English springer spaniels. The Habitat Help Desk is an area of the show floor dedicated to helping farmers and landowners meet their conservation and habitat goals on their property. Landowners can consult with trained wildlife biologists to gain insights into management activities, as well as what local, state and federal voluntary conservation programs may be available for their property. Additionally, there will be other opportunities to learn more about soil health, habitat management and precision agriculture. WHY HABITAT?

Two factors affect pheasant and quail populations above all others — habitat and weather. While we can't control the weather, we can influence the quality and quantity of upland habitat. Habitat is what supports strong and healthy pheasant and quail populations — and many other species of upland wildlife such as whitetails, monarch butterflies, honeybees and prairie songbirds — for the long term.



FARMER OF THE YEAR

#ACTFORGRASSLANDS

The North American Grasslands Conservation Act would establish federal legislation designed to provide landowners with voluntary, flexible economic incentives and opportunities to improve and conserve disappearing grasslands, sage brush, prairies and savannas. **Over 73 percent of America’s tallgrass, mixed grass and shortgrass prairies have vanished**, along with their ecological benefits and many iconic species. Total grassland bird populations have declined by more than 40 percent since 1966 and some species, like the lesser prairie chicken, teeter at the edge of extinction. Species that had been economically significant throughout American history like the bobwhite quail have seen declines of nearly 85 percent in the last half century.

Conservation organizations across the country, including Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever, BHA, TRCP, NWF, NAGP, The World Wildlife Fund, Izaak Walton League of America, Wildlife Mississippi, National Deer Association, Land Trust Alliance, Native American Fish and Wildlife Society, National Bobwhite Conservation Initiative, the American Bird Conservancy and the Buffalo Nations Grasslands Alliance have all been advocating for this effort for some time, though no legislation has been introduced as of yet. The panel will discuss the future of the idea and its potential impact on habitat, bird numbers, ranching communities and the overall health of grassland ecosystems nationwide. Alongside Howard Vincent on the panel will be Shaun Grassel, President of the Buffalo Nations Grasslands Alliance and a wildlife biologist for the Lower Brule Sioux Tribe, Land Tawney, president and CEO of Backcountry Hunters and Anglers (BHA), Whit Fosburgh, president and CEO of Theodore Roosevelt Conservation Partnership (TRCP) and Ted Koch, the executive director of the North American Grouse Partnership (NAGP). MeatEater’s Ryan Callaghan will moderate the panel. Callaghan is MeatEater’s director of conservation, host of the *Cal’s Week in Review* podcast and an advocate for the creation of the Grasslands Act.

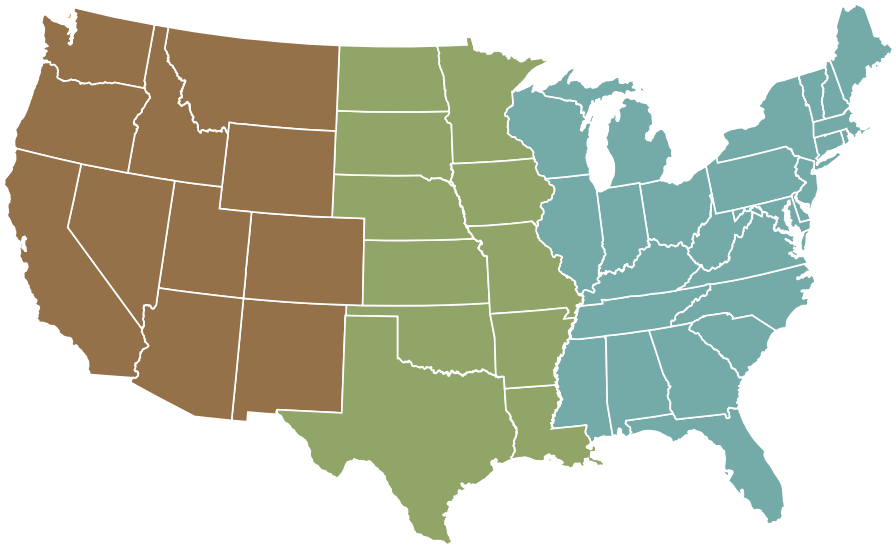

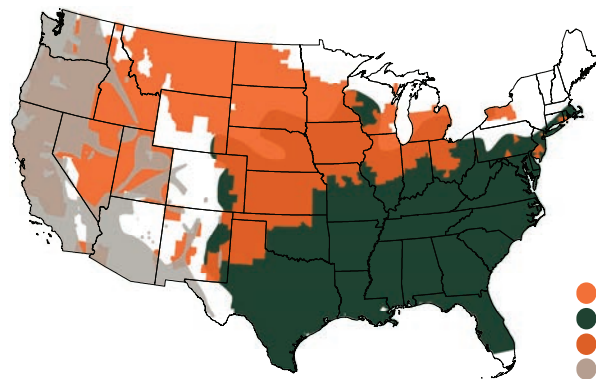

IN NEBRASKA



Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever has impacted 7 million acres of upland wildlife habitat in Nebraska since the organization's creation in 1982. That accomplishment can only happen with many partners working alongside.

With 97 percent of Nebraska privately owned, our habitat achievements are made in stride with the landowners, ranchers and farmers that take pride in the landscape and wildlife. Nebraska provides unique habitat incentives for landowners to enroll acreage.

Working Lands for Wildlife, focused in the Sandhills, provides eastern red cedar removal, grassland improvements and prescribed fire, all benefiting wildlife and landowners equally.

Pathway For Wildlife and **Corners For Wildlife** provide cropland-to-grassland conversion, habitat restoration, places to hunt, and soil health improvements through cover crops. Landowners achieve a variety of goals. Low-yield cropland seeded to prairie grass benefits pheasants, quail and pollinators, and provides an annual payment to increase the landowner's bottom line. Diverse and strategically placed cover crops offer an opportunity for wildlife cover in an agriculture-dominated landscape.

Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever work closely with the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission to offer public access for hunting and high-quality upland gamebird

habitat through the Open Fields and Waters Program, Habitat Share and the Berggren Pheasant Plan. Additional programs are also available through the expertise and guidance of the 20 Farm Bill biologists and 8 coordinating wildlife biologist that call Nebraska home.

Since 1995, Pheasants Forever has been able to provide habitat-driven programs with the help of many conservation partners. The Nebraska Game and Parks Commission, Natural Resource Conservation Service, The Farm Service Agency, The Nebraska Environmental Trust, Nebraska's Natural Resource Districts, the Rainwater Basin Joint Venture, The Nature Conservancy, The Sandhills Taskforce, the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service Partners Program and the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation are all key partners in helping us reach the 7-million-acre mark.

Thank you to everyone who has made Nebraska a habitat-friendly, resource-healthy, and wildlife-thriving home. Let's get going on the next million acres!

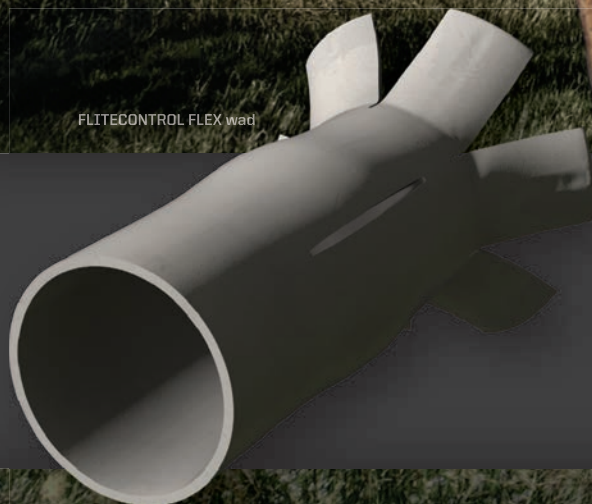
