Although our Learn to Hunt (LTH) program was originally focused on mentoring youth, it has expanded in scope to serve hunter-conservationists of all ages. Through our new Path to the Uplands initiative, Pheasants Forever & Quail Forever's adult focused LTH program aims to engage new audiences across the country in an effort to diversify our hunting community.

The objective of this program is to provide knowledge, skills, and an introduction to hunting through education and interaction with mentors and positive hands-on skill building activities in a controlled setting. Focused on building a unique setting around camaraderie, active involvement and social support, these events are a great way to allow adult participants to get afield, while educating them on the importance of firearm safety, conservation, and outdoor ethics. Outreach team can provide financial assistance and training for chapters to engage new audiences through collaborative efforts of volunteers, staff, and partners to Recruit, Retain and Reactivate more sportsmen and women.
